Required Paperwork:

The Pinellas County School Board (PCSB) and the Florida High School Athletic Association (FHSAA) set the rules for participation in high school sports and activities. All athletes must submit proper paperwork before they can participate in any activities — even practice.

- Athletic Forms Athletic Participation Paperwork may be found on the East Lake High School (ELHS) website under Athletics. (https://www.pcsb.org/eastlake-hs)
- Insurance Student Accident Insurance information may be found on the PCSB website under Athletics and Extracurricular Activities. (pcsb.org)
- Concussion Waiver Swimmers and divers will be required to complete the Concussion for Students online course. (Watch the video, create user ID, download the certificate.)

Instructions for submitting the Student Accident Insurance and Athletic Participation Paperwork may be found on the ELHS website under Athletics > Athletic Participation Packet. You will need to upload the notarized participation form, the physical form completed and signed by a physician, the insurance receipt and the final concussion waiver.

Additionally, our team utilizes Team Pages for communications. If you are new to the team, please visit http://eastlakeswimming.teampages.com and click JOIN TEAM on the right side. Enter all requested information for both the swimmer and parent to register.

AWAY MEET MEALS

The Booster Club provides a bag lunch to all athletes for away meets. We need parent volunteers to help assemble and deliver the lunches.

SPIRIT BAGS

TRANSPORTATION

SWIMMERS: All swimmers are required to ride the team bus to and from away meets. Coach uses the bus ride for instruction and team-building and needs all athletes present and engaged. All swimmers must wear their uniform: team suit, team shirt and black shorts.

The bus will pick up and drop off at the North Pinellas (Lansbrook) YMCA. Meet at 3:45 pm and check in with Coach. After the meet, all swimmers will return to the North Pinellas YMCA.

DIVERS: All divers must arrange their own travel due to different warm-up and meet times. All divers must wear their uniform: team suit, team shirt and black shorts.

Ten Commandments for Swim Parents

by Rose Snyder, Managing Director Coaching Division, USOC, Former Director of Club Services, USA Swimming (adapted from Ed Clendaniel's 10 Commandments for Little League Parents)

- I. Thou shall not impose thy ambitions on thy child. Remember that swimming is your child's activity. Improvements and progress occur at different rates for each individual.
- II. Thou shall be supportive no matter what. There is only one question to ask your child after a practice or a competition "Did you have fun?"
- III. Thou shall not coach thy child. Do not undermine the professional coach by trying to coach your child on the side. Your job is to provide love and support. The coach is responsible for the technical part of the job.
- IV. Thou shall only have positive things to say at a swimming meet. You should be encouraging and never criticize your child or the coach. Both of them know when mistakes have been made.
- V. Thou shall acknowledge thy child's fears. New experiences can be stressful. It is appropriate for your child to be scared. Your job is to encourage and assure your child that they can do it.
- VI. Thou shall not criticize the officials. Please don't criticize those who are doing the best they can in purely voluntary positions.
- VII. Honor thy child's coach. The bond between coach and swimmer is special. It contributes to your child's success as well as fun. Do not criticize the coach in the presence of your child.
- VIII. Thou shall be loyal and supportive of thy team. A swim team consists of members of various ages and skill levels. One of the most fun parts is to see the groups cheering for each other.
- IX. Thy child shall have goals besides winning. Most successful swimmers have learned to focus on the process and not the outcome. Giving an honest effort, regardless of the outcome, is much more important than winning. One Olympian said, "My goal was to set a world record. Well, I did that, but someone else did it too, just a little faster than I did. I achieved my goal and I lost. Does this make me a failure? No, in fact I am very proud of that swim." What a tremendous outlook to carry on through life.
- X. Thou shall not expect thy child to become an Olympian. There are 250,000 athletes in USA Swimming. There are only 52 spots available for the Olympic Team every four years. Your child's odds of becoming an Olympian are about .0002%.
